LABORATORY TESTS AUTHORIZATION

Advances in anesthesia and surgery have made routine procedures very safe, with a low rate of complications. Nevertheless, occasional problems can arise due to pre-existing conditions not evident during pre-anesthetic physical examinations. To minimize the risk of complications and to establish a baseline of medical data, we recommend blood tests prior to anesthesia and surgery. The type of test(s) recommended will depend on the physical condition of your pet and the nature of the surgery. General recommendations are listed below, and a technician will answer any questions you may have when your pet is checked in for surgery.

_____ 1) Heartworm test: Recommended for dogs over the age of 5 months and not currently on heartworm prevention.	\$33.00
_____ 2) Feline Leukemia, Feline Immunosuppressive Virus (FeL V/FIV) Recommended for cats that go outdoors or cats with unknown backgrounds.	\$39.64
_____ 3) Minor Health Screen / Hemocrit, BUN, Total Protein. Recommended for healthy, young (less than 8 years old) pets.	\$ 29.66
_____ 4) Complete Blood Count (CBC) / Biochemical Profile. Recommended for senior pets (8 years old and over), and / or systemic disease present and / or extensive surgery.	\$123.90
_____ 5) Urinalysis To measure kidney functions	\$48.30

_____ 6) AVID Microchip Placement	\$41.75
_____ 7) Ear cleaning / flushing	\$18.90
_____ 8) Nail Trim	\$10.75
_____ 9) Hip Radiographs (to help detect dysplasia in large breed dogs) Although dysplasia can often be detected at a younger age, dogs must be at least 2 years old for the hip radiographs to be certified by the OFA	\$115.00
